MINUTES OF THE 1ST MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE WEST BENGAL FOREST & BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION SOCIETY

The 1st Meeting of the restructured Governing Body of the West Bengal Forest and Biodiversity Conservation Society was held on 22.06.2023. The meeting was chaired by Shri Soumitra Dasgupta, Chairperson of the Society. The following members / Special Invitees were present.

The Chief Project Director, WBFBCP Project & Member Secretary of the WBFBC Society presented each agenda followed by discussion. The agenda-wise presentation and decisions are given below:

1. Confirmation of the minutes of the 17th meeting held on 30th March, 2023

Governing Body was informed that no communication in respect of minutes of 17th meeting of Governing Body was received.

Decision:

i) Minutes of the 17th meeting of the Governing Body stand confirmed.

Action:

No Action required.

2. Discussion on the Action Taken Report on the resolutions of the minutes of the 17th meeting held on 30th March, 2023

The Action Taken Report on the resolutions of the minutes of 17th meeting was presented before the Governing Body. Members advised on following points:

Sl. No- 4 (Presentation of Annual Reports of West Bengal Forest and Biodiversity Conservation Project for the years 2021-22)

PCCF, RMD advised to Member Secretary to make CF, WP & GIS as convenor of the committee to oversee the progress of digitization of Forests on quarterly basis and devise effective mechanism for the issue.

Sl. No. 7 (Approval for appointment of Auditors for Internal Audit and Statutory Audit of the Society Account for 2022-23)

Chairperson asked to complete the process of appointment of statutory audit firm within one week.

Decision: Action taken report is accepted

3. Vetting of the Operation Manual

Members Secretary made a Power Point presentation on Operation Manual. Members appreciated on the "Consideration of Gender and Differently abled" point. Members asked to relook some aspects of the manual and make necessary amendments addressing the issue.

Chapter-8 (Delegation of Powers)

Delegation of Financial Power structure was formed to be inadequate at the level of CPD & the Governing Body. It was also decided that delegation of Financial Power will be applicable as per existing norms of Govt. of W.B. for all ranks of officers except for CPD & Governing Body.

Chapter- 10 (Tally Accounting System)

Members advised to organise sensitization/training of implementing Head, DMUs under WB-FBCCCR regarding Tally Accounting System an inception workshop was also required.

Decision:

i) CPD expressed that sensitization /training would be held prior to initiation of implementation of WB-FBCCCR and an inception workshop would be held prior initiation of activities of the project.

4. Approval of Heads of Accounts

The detailed Heads of Accounts based on the funds allocated by the JICA in various categories as per the MoD were placed before the Governing Body for approval.

<u>Decision</u>: The Governing Body approved the detailed Heads of Accounts for the purpose of the project.

5. Approval for Engagement of Contractual Staff

<u>Decision:</u> The members accorded their approval.

6. Approval for Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Soil and Land Use Survey of India (SLUSI)

The Chairperson and members raised some reservation in the selection of SLUSI for the preparation of CAT Plan and advised that a pilot be tested in Medinipur DMU having elephant infested area like Lalgarh and based on the work outcome to move forward. Alternatively it was also suggested that EOI/ RFP mode may be explored in consultation with APCCF, WL (HQ).

7. Approval for APO for 2023-2024.

Decision: The members accorded their approval on APO for 2023-2024.

8. Production of QPM in Central Nursery under WB-FBCCCR:

The matter of raising one and half year old seedling in nurseries prior to the plantation was flagged by CPD. It was brought to the attention of the members that the nurseries need to be upgraded for minimum 750cc – 1000cc hycopots for sustaining tall seedlings. Alternatively it was also noted that the polypots may be tried provided that their shifting every 15-20 days is ensured to avoid the grounding of roots in the nurseries. The members discarded the second option and advised that it will not be good to go back in time. Finally it was decided that a committee be formed under the Chairmanship of APCCF, Wildlife, Head Quarter to decide and finalize the selection of appropriate dimension of hycopots with reference to size, shape and volume for raising of tall seedlings. It was also decided that the committee be given two weeks of time to submit the report so that the matter may be resolved soon for the implementation of the project.
